TRANSPORTATION

Tallinn airport is the nearest airport.

CLUB FACILITIES

PRACTICE AREA

A practice putting green, bunker practice and a short game area and full driving range are available next to the Clubhouse. Practice area is open every day from 7.00 a.m.

TROLLEYS

Trolleys are available.

GOLF BAGS

Golf Bags may be stored at the Golf Club.

LOCKERS

The locker rooms are situated in the clubhouse opposite to the Reception. One locker for personal belongings will be made available to each player. Keys will be available from the Reception.

GOLF SHOP

The golf shop supplies popular brands of golf balls and clothing.

CATERING

Breakfast is served at the hotel. Breakfast is included in the accommodation fee.

COURSE DETAILS



Estonian Golf & Country Club

Estonian Golf & Country Club golf complex is made up of an 18-hole Championship Sea Course built on the seaside and in a mature forest and a 9-hole British links style Stone Course with its renewed stone fences, junipers and nationally protected ancient sites. Both courses are designed by the Finnish younger generation golf course designer and a professional golf player Lassi Pekka Tilander. The facility also boasts an extensive practice facility to help develop all facets of the game. Height differences on the Championship course exceed 40 metres. Numerous ponds, oaks and large pre-historic stones in the middle of the fairways, seaside and Jägala river delta with its soviet time hanging bridge make it an exceptional golf course at its best. On one side, the seaside holes on the Championship course and the entire Stone Course are open to the fresh sea winds, giving your game that British links feeling. Tens of official ancient relic sites and the ancient forest on the opposite side balance this, giving you an experience of Estonia from centuries long ago.

The Clubhouse is designed as a central building of the complex. The building is situated on the edge of a limestone bank. Perfect location provides picturesque views from the building and terraces in all directions – to the sea, golf holes and limestone bank. From the architectural point of view the Clubhouse is designed as an archeotype of a powerful historic rural manor housefarm. The restaurant is situated on the top floor to ensure best views on the surrounding environment. The general design gives a traditional, wild and homely feeling appropriate to the location. The Clubhouse has Pro-shop, dressing rooms with saunas, a restaurant with spacious terrace, cosy seminar room and small archaeology museum as well as golf library.



The Course – Sea Course

Sea Course is a true Championship Course. The holes are built on virgin forests reaching out until to the beach and to the Jägala river. The difference between the heights is up to 40 meters, oak pathways, old boulders and natural ponds has given Estonian Golf & Country Club the chance to create a true pearl of golf that cannot be found so easily in the world.

With its holes length (in total 6462 meters / 7070 yards from back tees and 5422 meters / 5932 yards from blue tees) and complexity the Sea Course is a real challenge even for the high-qualified golfers.
