## SUMMARY

Spain took the most advantage of the many points on offer in the Ladies' British Open Amateur and, with two players reaching the final, they have taken first position from France who have been leading the ELITE since its inception. Sweden has moved to third closely pursued by England. Germany has journeyed down the ladder despite an exceptional performance by Caroline Masson this week, but this is largely because of a relatively high divisor. Other teams will have to match them in points in future events if they are to hold their positions. Italy gains three positions; from 13<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> and Ireland two to be 6<sup>th</sup>. Switzerland joins Division 1 and their absence allows several teams to come up one position in Division 2. Israel's Laetitia Beck has single-handedly earned her country an extra place, however, moving them into third.
