Congratulations to the Top-Ranked Players in the Ladies' European Amateur Ranking 2011. Final results for 2011 (as of 8 January 2012) were:

1	Stephanie Meadow	Ireland	1588.68 pts
2	Leona Maguire	Ireland	1531.37 pts
3	Charley Hull	England	1452.17 pts

Stephanie Meadow, presently based in the US, won the Lady Puerto Rico Classic early season. She followed by winning the Sugar Bowl Intercollegiate. She reeled-off another three top-four US finishes before winning the NCAA East Regional Championship by six strokes. Back in Europe, she took the second place in both the Irish Open Stoke Play Championship and the European Ladies' Amateur.

Leona Maguire started her season by winning the Portuguese Ladies' Amateur Open and followed with a second consecutive French Under-21 title. In June, she won the Irish Open Stroke Play Championship. Two months later, she took the British Ladies' Open Stroke Play Championship by six strokes, concluding with a pair of 69s to end the tournament as the only player to match par at the Royal Ashdown Forest course, England.

Charley Hull's season highlights included a first place in the Welsh Ladies' Open Stroke Play Championship and runner-up in the English Ladies Amateur Championship. She also won the English Women's Stroke Play Championship at Alwoodley GC by four strokes.
