The South Course at Quinta do Lago has hosted the Portuguese Open no less than eight times since the course was designed by William Mitchell in 1974. With its reputation as one of the premier courses in Europe and a flagship European Tour course, Quinta do Lago South enjoys an iconic status.

It was the South Course where Colin Montgomerie captured the first of his 24 European Tour titles in 1989, setting a new course record with a final round of 63. With two of the finest practice facilities in the area, the Quinta do Lago resort also attracts many top professional and amateur golfers who come here looking for first-class facilities and the finest conditions in which to improve their game.

The par course par 72 course is set amongst umbrella pines, lakes and wild flowers, overlooking the spectacular scenery of the Ria Formosa National Park. Accurate tee shots are essential in order to reach many of the greens in regulation and the course is made more challenging by a good variety of doglegs and strategically located hazards. The front nine holes, which wind their way through parkland, favour a draw, while the back nine, which loop around the lake, favour a fade from the tee.

Shuttle Service

Bus Shuttle service will be provided for participants upon arrival and departure from/to Faro International Airport.

Participants and accompanying officials are scheduled to arrive on, 27 and 28 June, and to leave on Sunday, 2 July. Transfer between the official hotel and Faro international airport will be organized accordingly.

It is kindly requested that the 'Travel details' form is duly filled in and returned to the PGF before Thursday, 15 June 2017, if you wish to use the shuttle service.

Team Fee

The team fee per team is € 600. (the teams for the team championship and the Nations Cup Being two different teams)- and will be paid upon registration (credit card available) or by Bank transfer to the Portuguese Golf Federation. It will cover transfers between airport and official hotel, practice balls, pull trolleys, yardage books, team photographs and social events **for 4 players and a captain.**

The "participation fee" for non-players travelling with the teams is € 100.- per person. It will cover transfers between airport and hotel and social events. It will be paid together with the Team fee.

The total amount of the team fees should be paid by bank transfer to the account of the Portugal Golf Federation and please ensure that all bank charges are met by your Federation.

Prizes

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd, respectively.

Dress Code

A reasonable standard of golf clothes (no jeans) is required at all times on the course and in the club house. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course.

Practice

Official practice day: -Wednesday, 28 June.

The practice day must be reserved by mvitoria@quintadolagocom (Mr. Mario Vitoria) +351 289 390 700.

One ball only may be played during practice rounds, with the following exceptions:

- a) If a player misses the green with his shot to the green, he may play one additional shot.
- b) Where the Rules of Golf apply (e.g. provisional ball).
- c) A player may practice putting, chipping or bunker play, provided play is not delayed.

Players should discontinue such practice immediately when the following group is waiting to play.

Practice balls cannot be used on the championship course.

Transportation: Players must not ride on any form of transportation during any part of an official practice round unless authorised by the Committee.

Failure to respect these Practice Rounds regulations will result in the discontinuance of the practice round.

Practice Facilities

Driving range, chipping and putting green will be open from 7h00 am until 8h00 pm daily.

Golf Bag Storage

Golf bag storage will not be available in the club house.

Golf Shop

Golf shop with a limited range of golf equipment and clothing is located in the Club

Trolleys

\Pull trolleys are available (included in the Team Fee).
