We, the members of the Koninklijke Haagsche Golf and Country Club (The Royal Hague Golf & Country Club), are honored, proud and happy to be able to host the 2018 European Amateur Championship from the 27th till 30th of June on our course in Wassenaar.

The history of the club almost equals the history of Dutch golf. The construction in 1889 of its first holes in the Hague is considered the factual introduction of golf in our country. A few years later on April 3, the second day of Easter 1893 a small group of these first participants of the game founded the first Dutch club: "the Hague Golf Club". Therefore this same club now named KHG&CC celebrates during the year 2018 its 125th anniversary.



During the lifetime of the club it has hosted many international championships. Starting with the first Dutch Open in 1912, of which a further 19 editions were held till 1981. In 1987 it hosted the Dutch Ladies Open, the European Amateur Team Championship visited us in 1997 and 2003. More recently from 2010 - 2012 we were host to three consecutive editions of the professional Dutch Senior Open and finally last year the first combined male, female International Dutch Senior Open was organized in July 2017.

During her time of existence the club has been playing on two courses, first in "Clingendael Waalsdorp" in The Hague and later on the "Wildhoeve " in Wassenaar. In 1947 after 58 years the club had to leave the original location on the outskirts of The Hague mainly due to the severe damage sustained during World War II. We were very fortunate to be able to move that same year to Wassenaar to the present location, a golfcourse which could be reinstated and reopened only a short time after the end of the war. This new course for the club, was originally a private initiative of Danïel Wolf, who commissioned the architects Alison and Colt to design a 18 holes course in the dunes. Right from the start in 1938 it was widely considered a very challenging, undulated, windswept 'inland' links course, which unfortunately had a only brief lifespan as it had to close after two years due to the outbreak of the war.

Since the reopening in 1947, the required maintenance of the course was over the years always done according to the principals of the original lay out and with attention and respect to our host Nature. Therefore we feel that our course can nowadays still be considered true to the challenges of the first design of Alison and Colt. This is one of the reasons we are looking forward to witness the performance and results of the top European contestants playing our course.

On behalf of the members and the board of the club, I wish all participants a competitive, challenging and enjoyable championship played in the spirit of the game.

Royal Hague Golf & Country Club

THE COURSE

Founded in April 1893, the Royal Hague Golf & Country Club is the oldest golf club in the Netherlands. Following the Second World War, the club moved to its current location amid the magnificent dunes of Wassenaar in 1947. The course is surrounded by the National Park 'Hollandse Duinen' and lies a mere 3.5 kilometers from the coast.

The Royal Hague Golf & Country Club has a rich history of hosting international tournaments. For example it was the site of the first Dutch Open in 1912 and has hosted a further 19 editions, the last being in 1981. It was also the venue for the Dutch Ladies Open in 1987 and was host for three editions of the Dutch Senior Open in 2010 until 2012.

In many golf course listings, in The Netherlands and Europe, the course is usually ranked among the top.

COLT

The current course was designed in 1938, by the famous golf course architects Harry Shapland Colt and Charles Hugh Alison. Although Alison was responsible for most of the design, as evidenced by the slightly larger bunkers and more extreme nature, the course is still counted as one of the best Colt designed courses in Europe.

CHARACTER OF THE COURSE

The design of the golf course makes use of the naturally undulating dune landscape. Each hole offers a completely different view and a new and surprising challenge. Teeing of on the 18th gives the golfer a wonderful view of the clubhouse and terrace.



PRACTICE FACILITIES

A practice putting green, short game area and driving range are available on site. Use of practice balls is free of charge. Be aware: it is <u>prohibited</u> to hit woods on the driving range during the practice days and tournament days. For woods there will be hitting bays with nets available.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

The official practice days are Monday and Tuesday between 7:00 and 16:00. Please reserve your tee-time for the practice rounds by sending an e-mail to topgolf@ngf.nl. Practice rounds can only be booked after publication of the list of participants by the EGA on Wednesday 23 May.

REGISTRATION AND TOURNAMENT OFFICE

All players are required to register before Tuesday 26 June at 12:00 noon. Players failing to do so or failing to notify the tournament office of their late arrival may lose their place in the championship. Registration will take place at the golfclub.

INFORMATION DESKS

There will be an information desk located at the entrance of the clubhouse and upon arrival in the official hotel.

NOTICE BOARDS

There will be notice boards located in the clubhouse and the reception area of the official hotel. Players should have a look at the notice boards at regular intervals as important information will be displayed here.

STARTING TIMES

The official tee times for the tournament rounds will be between 7:00 and 16:00 every day.

COURSE GUIDE:

A professional course guide will be sold to players upon registration.











TROLLEYS AND CADDIES

Caddies or electric trolleys are not available. Pull trolleys are available for all players.

BAG STORAGE

Golf bag storage is available and located near the driving range.

LOCKERS

One locker for personal belongings will be made available to each player. A deposit of 10 euro in cash will be required.

CATERING

The Clubhouse's restaurant will be open daily. A lunch buffet will be served every day. A small a la carte menu will also be available. Payment is only possible by debit or credit card.

CEREMONIES

The Closing Ceremony followed by the Farewell Cocktail party will take place around 17:30 on Saturday 30 June at the clubhouse.

DRESS CODE

A reasonable standard of dress is expected at all times, both on the course and in the clubhouse. Jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts and tracksuits are not permitted on the course. The Closimg Ceremony and Farewell Cocktail will be informal. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course and in the clubhouse.
