PROTECTION MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19

EUROPEAN BOYS TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- 1. The RFEG organizing committee present at the tournament will undergo a preventive test before the start of the competition.
- 2. The players and Team delegations (Captain, Coaches and Officials) and EGA Officials must present a negative COVID 19 Test (PCR), tested within 72 hours of arrival.
- 3. The number of participants will be 64, and to avoid any crowding they will all start from the same tee and every 12 minutes.
- 4. The players and their companions, on the official training day, and before 12:00 noon, must deliver to the tournament office a **declaration** in which the signatories state that they have no symptoms of COVID, have not lived or have no knowledge of having been in contact with infected people, and undertake the commitment to inform the organization if they suffer symptoms during and after the tournament.
- 5. In the case a player informs the organization that he has symptoms compatible with those of COVID, the player will be isolated, referred to the nearest Health Center for evaluation and in the case that he tests positive for COVID, the health authorities will be immediately informed so that they can proceed according to the current regulations.
- 6. The number of companions per player is limited to 1, in order to avoid crowding and to facilitate the development of the competition in safe conditions for all.
- 7. Each player will be allowed access to the field only 90 minutes before the start. At the end of his round, he will be able to use the practice facilities for 1 hour.
- 8. The organization will place disinfectant hydrogel dispensers in strategic places: tee 1 and 10, next to the water coolers, practice range, putting green, card delivery, entrance to the club facilities, toilets, and any place that the organization considers strategic to ensure the safety of the players.
- 9. The local rules and permanent local rules of the RFEG, as well as pin positions, will be published on the website and tournament notice board to avoid being distributed on the tee.
- 10. Reminder banners (social distance, masks where they cannot be guaranteed, hand washing, etc...) will be placed in strategic places.

DURING THE COMPETITION

1. Telematic cards should be used preferably, although disinfected scorecards will be available for those players who exceptionally need them.


- 2. The "Recording Area" will be protected with screens to ensure health safety.
- 3. Caddies will not be allowed in order to safeguard the health of the players.
- 4. Flags must be kept on the hole and may not be touched by the players. The hole will have a device to retrieve the ball from the hole without touching the flag.



5. The rakes will be removed from the bunkers and the raking must be done with the feet and the golf club.



- 6. The capacity of the practice areas will be limited to avoid crowding and to guarantee social distance.
- 7. The starting tees will have three points located with 2 meters distance, so that the players can place themselves with their bags and maintain a good social distance.





8. A line will be painted 10 metres behind of each tee that cannot be crossed if the next tee is occupied.



9. The exit from the green to the next tee will also have three points painted on the ground to place the golf bags and ensure safety distance.



The rules currently in place for health safety may vary at any time as stipulated by the responsible Administrations for this purpose.
