VENUE INFORMATION

CLUB DETAILS

The venue for the 2022 European Young Masters is Linna Golf in Finland.

Linna Golf is conveniently located in a city of Hämeenlinna, only I hour drive from Helsinki and its international airport. This idyllic course offers a great variety of beautiful landscapes and terrains. The course is built on Vanajanlinna Manor grounds and spans over IOO hectares, making for a spacious course.

The landscape takes full advantage of the splendid old woods in the area. One of the estate outbuildings that dates back to the beginning of the 20th century, has been fully renovated into a clubhouse, including a restaurant, saunas, dressing rooms, a golf shop and offices.

THE COURSE

Tim Lobb from European Golf Design (EGD) is the architect who designed the Linna Golf course. EGD is behind the designs for several well-awarded courses around Europe, including PGA Golf de Catalunya in Spain, Woburn in London, Berlin Sporting Club and the Carton House O'Meara course in Ireland.

Player feedback on the course

Since opening on August Ist 2005, the course has received praise from players for both its maintenance and design. Both local and international golf media have praised Linna Golf as the no I. golf course in Finland. Golf World has listed the facility among the top 60 golf resorts in Europe.

The Open Champion 1956, Peter Thomson had this to say concerning the course, after finishing his round:

"I doubt there is a better course in Scandinavia. The terrain is excellent and has been used in the best way possible to create a course with a great variety of holes which will challenge all standards of golfers. In time, I believe Linna Golf will become a national treasure."

Clubhouse

The clubhouse with dressing rooms will be open daily from 06:30 am to 9:00 pm.

Dress code

All competitors are kindly asked to dress properly throughout the whole event. Casual and clean golf clothing is required on the course and in the clubhouse. No caps indoor, please! Participating teams are recommended to perform in national playing uniform.

Golf bags

Players are kindly asked to store their bags in their rooms.

Golf shop

A Golf Shop is located in the clubhouse.

Internet access

A wireless internet access is available in the clubhouse area.

Lockers

There are team lockers allocated in the dressing rooms in the clubhouse.

Medical assistance

First Aid is available during the championship, so immediate help can be provided if so needed. Service desk is in the clubhouse. A doctor's assistance can be arranged within a IO-minute notice.

All tournament information will be placed on notice boards in the clubhouse.

Payment methods

Preferably major credit cards in all areas. The currency is Euro (€).
