### **Venue Information**

#### **Club Details**

The Diamond Course, the Lyoness Open venue on the outskirts of Vienna, has been chosen as the venue for the European Boys' Team Championship (Jean-Louis Dupont Trophy) 2016. The 18-hole championship course created by Jeremy Pern is based in a wonderful landscape in Tullner Field.

The club facilities include large practice areas, a pro shop, and cosy modern social areas. The restaurant, led by Gerhard Becher, serves fresh and delicious meals in the beautiful Diamond Clubhouse.

An unparalleled sun terrace produces the kind of atmosphere of relaxation you would gladly treat yourself after a round of golf.

The venue also boasts attractive off course facilities including a modern and spacious aparthotel, opened in 2015, an elegant clubhouse offering fine Lower Austrian cuisine and a Boat House restaurant overlooking the lake protecting the eighteenth hole.

#### The Course

The layout of the Diamond Course tests every player's abilities with numerous water hazards requiring good course management. Both challenging and scenic, water hazards threaten tee and approach shots on no less than nine holes.

The Championship course is held to European Tour standard the whole year and perfectly kept fairways and greens allow for precise shots and putts. A Round at the Diamond Course is often challenging, but always fair and beautiful.

Additional guests have to register at the Tournament Office, preferably prior to the first tournament round.

Please bring your national uniform with you in the morning. There will be no shuttle service to the hotel during the afternoon before the Closing Ceremony. Showers and Wardrobe are available in the clubhouse.

Transportation from the golf club to the Farewell Dinner (and return) will be provided directly after the Closing Ceremony.
