

Golf de Fontainebleau is located in the eponym forest, one of the biggest in France, located about 60 kilometres south of Paris, which has been for nearly 1000 years a great hunting place for all French monarchs and where they built, over centuries, the Palace described by Napoleon the 1st as "the real home of our kings".

Slightly more than 100 years ago, in 1908, a group of friends decided to build there a golf course, which was still quite rare at that time in France and chose for this purpose a part of the forest located just outside the city. After a few months with nine holes the course reached 18 holes designed by Frenchman Julien Chantepie, and was inaugurated on September 1909 by Arnaud Massy, the only French winner of The Open (so far!), James Braid and John Henry Taylor. A few years later, Tom Simpson, the great British, architect remodelled the course to give it the design which lasted broadly unchanged for more than 50 years. Then, in 1965, some members thought it was time to update the course to make it more challenging by modern standards, task devoted to Fred Hawtree whose son, Martin, keeps coming regularly to advise us and always keep the course "alive".

Fontainebleau's course has the privilege to wind through very old oaks, birch and pine trees, as well as plenty of heather and sandstone rocks (the sea was there a few million years ago!). It has also the luck to be built on a totally sandy soils, which allows it to remain dry year-round. It is always regarded as one of the very best French and even continental Europe courses.

Private club with some 300 adult golfing members (and more than 100 young players!), but open to visitors on week days, Fontainebleau has often hosted major individual or team events, including every year in the spring, for nearly a century, the Coupe Mouchy which gathers all the best French male amateurs.

All its members will be absolutely delighted to welcome EGA's Ladies' Club Trophy and will endeavor to make all players and officials fully enjoy their stay to Fontainebleau.

Charles de Gaulle Airport: 85,1km from the Golf de Fontainebleau







The official practice days are Tuesday 28 and Wednesday 29 September.

One ball only may be played during practice rounds, with the following exceptions:

- a) If a player misses the green with his shot to the green, he may play one additional shot.
- b) Where the Rules of Golf apply (e.g. provisional ball).
- c) A player may practice putting, chipping or bunker play, provided play is not delayed.

Players should discontinue such practice immediately when the following group is waiting to play.

Practice balls cannot be used on the championship course.

<u>Transportation:</u> Players must not ride on any form of transportation during any part of an official practice round unless authorised by the Committee.

Failure to respect this Practice Round regulations will result in the discontinuance of the practice round for the player in question.

Only team players are permitted to play the practice rounds.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FORM (Please fill in with capital letters)

According to French law, a Medical Certificate is required for all players entering an International Championship or National Competition in France including Club competitions.

We herewith draw your attention to this important rule included in the conditions of play. This is to be fulfilled in all sports and by all competition organizers.

Therefore, the French Golf Federation must receive the medical certificates duly filled in by a doctor even if the players are insured when they travel abroad and if a medical assistance covers all expenses.

Considering that some countries do not have such regulation and do not issue such certificates, a medical certificate form is prepared in advance that you will find hereunder.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

OF NO CONTRAINDICATION
TO THE PRACTICE OF GOLF

According to the French laws and rules, a Medical Certificate is required for all players entering any Official Competition played in France including International Championships.

We draw your attention to this important rule in the conditions of play. This measure is to be used in all sports and by all competitions' organizers who can be recognized as responsible.

Therefore the French Golf Federation must receive the medical certificates duly filled by a doctor <u>even if your players are well insured</u> when they travel abroad and if a medical assistance covers all expenses.

We know that some countries do not issue such certificates to their players. Therefore, you will find hereunder a form-sheet "medical certificate already personalized" to know what information needs to be on it.

All players need to fill in this medical certificate and attach it to their entry form on the www.ffgolf.org website.

The entry form won't be accepted if the player didn't fill and attach this document.

We hope you understand our position according the French law and are very happy to receive your players in French International Championships.

Please return this form duly completed to the French Golf Federation before the registration of the Championship.


