

The Club & Course

Sat between the Snowdonian Mountains and the mouth & estuary of the River Conwy, the Championship Links is the third oldest club in Wales (est. 1890) and a founding member of the then Welsh Golfing Union. In that time, the club has hosted a range of high profile Championships in both the amateur and professional ranks.













Conwy Golf Club

Facilities

Conwy Golf Club contains a Championship Links 18 hole golf course measuring just short of 7000 yards from the back tees. The club also has a fully serviced grass bay range, an extensive short game practice area complete with bunkers and a practice putting green.

The Clubhouse contains large and modern changing rooms complete with shower facilities. On the upper floor there are two bars, a restaurant and a comfortable lounge.







The 2021 Curtis Cup

Conwy Golf Club played host to the Curtis Cup just last year; providing a fitting venue for the 42nd Matches between the United States and Great Britain & Ireland.

A close match through-out, with the United States Team eventually triumphing 12 - 8.

On selected holes, it is likely forward teeing areas will be used on holes 3 and 16 during the Championship. Also in the event of strong winds, holes may be shortened. A variety of teeing areas may be used on all par 3's during the Championship













Championship Information

Format

A maximum of 20 teams comprising of six players shall compete. All players and teams will play two rounds of stroke play; the lowest five scores from the team of six to count to the team score each day.

The leading eight teams after round two will progress to the first flight of match play, where matches will consist of two foursomes games in the morning and five singles games in the afternoon whilst in medal contention. The next eight teams after round two will progress to the second flight of match play, where matches will consist of one foursomes game and four singles games. The final four teams after round two will progress to the third flight, where matches will consist of one foursomes game and four singles games.

Tee Times & Draw

All tee times will be published in the evening each day prior to each Championship round, and will published online and on official noticeboards at Conwy Golf Club and the Imperial Hotel:

- Shortly after 17.00hrs for the stroke play stages
- 30 minutes after the completion of the stroke play stages/previous day's match for the match play stages

Registration

Federations and Unions must submit player's names to Wales Golf no later than Thursday 23rd June. On-site registration at Conwy Golf Club will open from 8.00am on July 3 and close at 12.00 noon on July 4; team captains may register teams on behalf of the players.

Practice Rounds

All practice rounds on the official practice days will be at assigned times by the EGA. Players are to play one ball only; except players may play additional shots when:

- They have missed the green (one additional shot only)
- Where the Rules of Golf apply
- Chipping, putting or bunker play around the green provided play is not delayed.

Practice

Balls for the practice range and chipping greens will be provided. Players may use their own golf balls on the chipping and/or putting greens if they wish.

Trolleys

Pull trolleys will be provided for all competitors. Electric trolleys will not be available.

Course Planners

Championship Planners will be available for all competitors. Teams should specify if they would like distances in meters or yards on the travel and accommodation form.











Locker Rooms

There are locker rooms at Conwy Golf Club which are free to be used by all competitors and team staff. Shower facilities at the club are available for use. Each team will be assigned and have the use of a locker at the club.

Bag Stores

There is no bag store facility at the host club; competitors will be required to take their clubs back to their rooms each day.

Catering

The kitchen will be open at Conwy Golf Club one hour before first tee time through to the close of play. Additionally, breakfast will be available and included at the Official Hotel.

Teams will have exclusive use of the dining room at the golf club throughout the Championship. There will be a special menu in place; any specific dietary requirements or allergies can be included in the team list or directly with the club upon arrival.

All teams will have access to an account for food and beverage, which they must clear prior to the end of the Championship on the 9th July.

Dress Code

The dress code for the Championship is smart casual standard golf attire. National Team Formal attire for the Opening & Closing Ceremonies, and the Gala Dinner. There is no dress code in the official hotel.

Team Rooms

Team rooms for meetings can be booked at the official hotel; they will be on a first come first served basis.

Additional Information

Full Championship Information Documents will be published and circulated to all competing teams around 2 weeks prior to the start of the Championship.


Alternative Accommodation

Transfers & Transport

There will be a coach service available to all players and team staff throughout the Championship. This will transfer you from Manchester International Airport to Llandudno on the 2nd July and from Llandudno to Manchester International Airport on the 10th July. There will also be a shuttle service running between the town of Llandudno and Conwy Golf Club throughout the Championships.

Shuttle Service

Exact timings and directions of the shuttle service will be confirmed nearer the time, but it is intended that shuttle coaches will make stops at up to 3 locations in Llandudno each trip. Teams which follow the accommodation guidance above will be serviced by the shuttle coaches. Please complete the attached accommodation and transport form to provide the best service possible and assist with administration

Other Accommodation and Travel

There is no obligation to use the organised transport or accommodation in this document. However any team wishing to book alternatives to the information provided must be prepared to handle their own accommodation and travel arrangements for the duration of the Championship. This includes:

- Flying to and from another airport teams will be required to organise their own airport transfers
- Staying in other accommodation elsewhere teams will be required to organise their own transport to and from Conwy Golf Club.
