ABOUT ESTONIA

Estonia is situated in northeastern Europe and juts out into the Baltic Sea, which surrounds the country from the north and west.

Estonia's capital Tallinn is the best preserved medieval city in Northern Europe. Many Estonians speak English, Russian, Finnish and German as well as Estonian. Estonia is about 50% forest and has over 2000 islands. Estonia is a digital society and has a population of just 1.3 million, but is larger than Denmark and Holland.









ESTONIAN GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

Estonian Golf & Country Club offers golfers a 9 hole links style Stone Course and an 18 hole championship level Sea Course.

The Sea Course with it's 18 holes stretching over 6500 meters, is a true championship golf course. Holes built among unspoiled forests reach out to the beach and play along the Jägala River.

With an overall elevation change of 40 meters, oak alleys, ancient boulders, and natural ponds the site is befitting of world class golf course. Due to the length and complexity, the Sea Course is a real challenge even for the golfer of the highest skill level.









CHAMPIONSHIP INFO

Entries

Entry is available via the European Golf Association (EGA) website <u>www.ega-golf.ch</u> Closing day for entries: **Monday 25th April at 5 pm**, CET.

Registration

Team captains are asked to register their players at the Tournament Office in the club house before 12 pm (noon) on Monday 29th August.

Clubhouse

The clubhouse is opened 1h prior to the first tee time.

Catering

Breakfast is included in Hotel services.

Lunch will be available to purchase at the DaVinci Golf restaurant at the Estonian Golf & Country Club.

Restaurant is opened every day from 11am to 9pm.

Water and fruits will be available for all players and captains on the course during the practice round and championship days.

Practice Facilities

Driving range, chipping and putting greens will be open for players 1h prior to the first tee time daily.

Practice round

Official practice round will take place on **Monday 29th August**, based on the EGA official draw for practice round.

Rental Trolleys

Manual trolleys will be available at the golf course. Trolley handles are located at club house. We kindly request all the players to return the trolley immediately after the end of his round to make it available to other players.

Electric trolleys are not available for rent.

Ceremonies

The Opening Ceremony will be held on Monday 29th August at the clubhouse of Estonian Golf & Country Club or its surroundings.

The Closing Ceremony will be held on Saturday 3rd September, after the end of the last match.









CHAMPIONSHIP INFO

Dress Code

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times, both on the course and in the clubhouse. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course.

Team uniforms are expected for ceremonies and the official team photos. The welcome and farewell cocktail parties will be informal.

Bag Storage

Golf bags may be stored in players lockers in the locker room.

Lockers

Lockers will be made available for the teams, labeled with flags of the respective country. Lockers will be distributed equally between all teams.

Information boards & desks

There will be information desk located in the clubhouse. Players should have a look at the information boards at regular intervals as important information will be displayed relating to tee-times, messages, transportation etc. All the information will also be on the competition pages: <u>EGA Championship</u> <u>page</u> and <u>Estonian Golf Association</u> <u>page</u>.

Transportation

Transportation will be organised between the official airports and the official hotels (Tallink City Hotel, Tallink Spa Hotel), as well as between the official hotels and the golf club. The schedule will be established at a further date.

The shuttle service will be provided only for the teams staying at the official hotels. The teams who decide not to stay at the official hotels will organise and cover their own transports.

Team Photo

A Team photo session is scheduled on Monday 29th August, at the golf club. The timetable will be recieved upon registration.

TRANSPORTATION

How to get to the course by car:

Situated just half an hour from the centre of Estonia's capital city Tallinn. You can reach Estonian Golf & Country Club by driving on the St Petersburg highway. The sign shows towards EGCC (you will also see a separate deceleration lane for making this left turn!). Drive along the road until you come to the EGCC welcome board, turn to the left in front of that board and you are there!

By taxi:

Best is to use app like Bolt or Tallink Takso +372 640 8921.

By official transport:

Transportation to and from the official hotels will be provided on the days of Team arrivals (Sunday, 28th August & Monday 29th August) and on the day of Team departures (Sunday, 3rd September).

Buses will be departing to and from the airport in fixed, most suitable intervals, depending on the flight information given by each team in the Travel Form. The schedule will be announced and made available on a further date.

Transportation from official hotel to the golf course and back will be provided on practice day and all championship days.
