










MAP

TEAM FEE

The Team Fee per Team will be determined later and communicated to the registered teams in due course. It will be paid upon registration to the French golf federation. It will cover transfers between airport/railway station and official accommodations (and the golf club on first and last days), practice balls, pull trolleys, yardage books, team photographs and social events (for 6 players and a captain).

The participation fee for additional individuals travelling with the teams is 250€ per person. It will cover transfers between airport and official accommodations (and the golf club on first and last days) and social events. It will be paid together with the Team fee.

REGISTRATION

Registration is open on Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 July, from 9:00am to 19:00pm at the Club House.

Participating teams are requested to register at the club house immediately following their arrival, at the venue. A team failure to register or to pre-notify the Committee of its pending arrival time may result in the team losing its starting field place reservation.

PRIZE

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd, respectively.

DRESS CODE

A reasonable standard of golf clothes (no jeans) is required at all times on the course and in the club house. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course.

PRACTICE

The official practice days are Sunday 9 and Monday 10 July.

Only team players are permitted to play the practice rounds.

A team player, team captain or advice giver will not be allowed to practice on the championship course for a period of **fifteen days prior to the first official practice day**, unless he or she is a member of the golf club at which the championship is being played.

Practice range will open from 8.00 am to 20.00 on practice days, and from one hour prior the first tee time during the tournament.

A putting green and a chipping area are accessible for the players.













CLUB HOUSE FACILITIES

The Club House facilities (Welcome Desk, Restaurant, Practice Range...) will open from 8.00 am to 20.00 on practice days, and from one hour prior the first tee time during the tournament.

Lockers will be made available for each team, in the Men lockers room, only accessible for the players and staff. Nation flag will help identify them.

Bags storage will be available at the Caddy Master. Signage will help localize it. Details will be available at the Caddy Master

CATERING

Breakfast will be served from one hour prior to the first tee time.

Lunch will be served from 11.00 am until 3.00 pm, A hot and cold buffet will be made available.

Any Nations will be able to open an account and pay for its consumptions by the end of the tournament.

A deposit may be asked.

ON COURSE WATER POINTS

Beside the 1st tee and between holes 5 & 6, 9 & 10, 12 & 13 and 15 & 16.

NO WATER BOTTLE WILL BE SUPPLIED ON THE COURSE (INCLUDING 1ST AND 10TH TEES).
