JOB DESCRIPTION

The European Golf Association is in search of an intern to assist the team with the upcoming championship season.

The paid internship would last from 4 to 6 months, with a start date around April/May and an end date near September/October (dates are flexible, but must include the peak months of June, July and August).

The intern will report directly to the General Secretary but will work alongside all five members of the EGA team on a wide variety of tasks.

The main responsibilities of the intern will be communications related. Notably, helping create content for and managing the EGA's website and social media channels. The intern will also support the other members of the EGA team with tasks such as website administration, responding to general inquiries, and coordinating aspects of the EGA's international events.
