



INTERNATIONAL EUROPEAN MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP



Eligibility of Competitors & Cut

When the championship was created in 1991, one of its goals was to gather former international players having decided not to join the professional ranks, but still wishing to compete at a high level of the amateur game.

The championship has been very successful and several prestigious names have joined Alexis Godillot (Fra), winner of the first edition played at Ascona GC, Switzerland, on the Trophy. Among these, we should mention Hans-Günter Reiter (Ger; 1999, 2002, 2003), François Illouz (Fra; 2000, 2010) Gary Wolstenholme (Eng; 2006, 2007) and Marcus Frank (Swi; 1996, 1997).

Over time, people have turned professional in greater numbers and much earlier, making the gap between the «turning-pro» age and 35 too big.

In order to further increase the competitiveness of the event, the EGA Championship Committee has decided to apply the following conditions' changes for 2015 and onwards:

NEW CONDITIONS 2015

Eligibility of Competitors:

- ⌚ Age limit: 30 years or over as of 0.00 hrs on Day 1 of the Championship
- ⌚ Handicap Limit: handicap of 3.0 or better

Cut:

- ⌚ The 60 lowest scores after the first 36 holes, including ties, will qualify for the final 18 holes.
