The first three ranked players will receive formal recognition for their achievement and be awarded EGA medal prizes at the 2009 European Amateur and Ladies' Amateur Team Championships.

2009 Ladies' European Amateur Ranking

A new European Ladies' Amateur Ranking (LEAR) will begin in 2009 and is an adaption of the proposed Women's World Amateur Golf Rankings (WWAR). It will be administered in the same way, but has a selected sub-set of events, mostly European. The LEAR will be more comprehensive than the current Ladies' ranking system used by the EGA and will be used as the basis for player points in the EGA Ladies' International Team Eclectic or "ELITE" (see article, current edition). The EGA



will still be accumulated solely by points earned in the LEAR counting events as listed. The first counting event for the season will be the Portuguese Ladies Open Amateur.

EGA Ladies' International Team Eclectic (ELITE)

Following requests for а European Ladies' Team League and general acknowledgement that international ladies' championships around open Europe would benefit from further participation, the EGA Championship Committee has developed the EGA Ladies' International Team Eclectic (ELITE).

The ELITE is calculated using the Ladies'European Amateur Ranking points from a set number of players from each participating country to make a running national total, i.e., an eclectic. A divisor is used so that countries can compete on equal footing, provided that a minimum number of players contribute a minimum number of rounds. For more information, including the

European Senior and Girls' Team Championship Formats

The European Senior Team Championship format has undergone further review. By popular request, the match play format will be extended one day at the cost of one practice day. Commencing in 2009, the match play format will based on flights of eight teams. The week's format will thus be one practice day, Days 1 and 2 stroke play, Days 3, 4 and 5 match play.

The European Girls' Team Championship format will change to the staging of two foursomes only for teams in medal contention; other teams are to play one foursomes match only (instead, formerly, of two). This change will also be instigated in 2009.

EGA International Match Captains 2009

Captain for the 2009 Jacques Léglise Trophy Continent of Europe Team will be Andreas Pallauf (Austria) and Vagliano Trophy Continent of Europe Team Captain will be Macarena Campomanes (Spain).
