Congratulations to the Top Ranked Players in the Ladies European Amateur Ranking 2010.

The final results for 2010 were:

Caroline Hedwall has had an extraordinary year on both sides of the Atlantic. Based at Oklahoma State University, she won the NCAA Women's individual title, Lady Puerto Rico Classic, Arizona Wildcat Invitational, Big 12 Championship and the Golfweek Conference Challenge. In Europe, she won the European Ladies' Team Championship with the Swedish national team, the Ladies' British Amateur Qualifying and was leading amateur at the Women's British Open and Finnair Masters. Playing at such a high level, Caroline made the decision to turn professional at the end of the season.

Leona Maguire's season highlights include winning the French Lady Juniors Championship and the Duke of York Young Champions Trophy.

Marta Silva, who, like Caroline, has been based in the US this year, amassed many of her points in NCAA events before returning home during the summer to win the National Spanish Ladies' Championship.
