Registration

Captains must register their team at the Golf Ireland Championship Office on Saturday 5th or Sunday 6th July at the times specified in the schedule above.

Local Rules and Terms of the Competition

Captains will receive the Local Rules and Terms of Competition by electronic format. In addition, both the Local Rules and Terms of Competition will be posted on the event notice board.

Anti-doping

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping policy https://www.igfgolf.org/integrity/anti-doping. Any players who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the EGA Office not later than 30 days prior to the start of the championship.

Practice

The official practice days are Sunday 4 July and Monday 5 July. The practice range will open one hour prior to first tee time and close at 5pm.

Trolleys

Pull-trolleys will be available for all players.

Please note your requirement for trolleys on the Team Members Form.

The trolleys are paid for through the Team Fee.

Yardage Book

Yardage book will be provided at Registration.

Fruit and Water

Complimentary fruit and water will be available on the course on practice and tournament days.

Credit/Debit Cards

Payment of expenses at the hotel and golf club can be made by credit/debit card.

Mail Boxes

An electronic form of mail box will be used throughout the event.

Team Photos

A photo session is scheduled for Monday 7th July prior to the Opening Ceremony. Timetable to be circulated. Dress code is the official National Team uniform.

You do not need a visa to land in Ireland if you:

- Are a citizen of the EU or the EEA (the EU plus Iceland, Norway and Lichtenstein) or Switzerland
- ☐ Have a residence card issued by an EEA country or Switzerland because you are the family member of an EEA or Swiss citizen living in a country outside of the EEA/Swiss family member's home country (for example, you live in Germany with your French spouse)
- ☐ Have a UK short-stay visa and qualify for the short-stay visa waiver or the British-Irish Visa Scheme (see 'Visa waivers for UK visa holders' below)
- ☐ Are a school student who lives in an EU/EEA country and you are travelling as part of a school trip (see 'School Student Visa Waiver' below)
- ☐ Are a citizen of a country listed in the table below.
