General Information

Bokskogens GC is located 20 minutes east of Malmö in Southern Sweden. The Old course is a Championship Level golf course maintained to the highest European standards. It is known for hosting European Tour event, World and European Championships and Scandinavian Tour finals.

Bokskogens GC is a club that thrive for good golfers. It has hosted many tournaments, has a great junior program and has developed five European Tour players.

The club has founded and hosted seven The Swedish Invitational for paragolfers, has hosted the first ever World Championship in Paragolf Team in 2011 and hosted Swedish Championship in Paragolf.



Travel and Accommodation

It is recommended that flights are booked to Copenhagen International Airport. Rooms are available at Malmö Arena Hotel in Malmö, and you can book your accommodation in the entry form below. Please make your hotel reservations no later than 2 June to guarantee availability.
