

MODEL LOCAL RULE G-12

PROHIBITING USE OF ANY MATERIALS TO HELP READ THE LINE OF PLAY FOR STROKE FROM PUTTING GREEN



During a round, you or your caddy must not use any written, printed, electronic or digital materials to help with reading your line of play for any stroke to be made from the putting green.

This includes using your yardage book, any charts, graphs or other notes when your ball is on the putting green for the specific purpose of reading your line of play.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THIS RULE:

Penalty for first breach:

Penalty for second breach:

DISQUALIFICATION



Yardage books are permitted for any use other than to help with reading your line of play for any stroke to be made from the putting green such as determining yardage from the fairway or noting what club you hit.



A caddy or an advice giver is also not allowed to use a yardage book (or any other materials) to help determine the line of play for a stroke to be made from the putting green.
