

EGA SPECTATOR CONDUCT POLICY

GENERAL CONDUCT

1. Spectators must observe the same golf etiquette and respect to the golf course, facilities, and policies of the host club as the players.
2. Spectators are welcome to walk on the course but must keep to the sides of the rough and to the cart paths. Spectators should position themselves in a safe place not interfering with play
3. Please keep a reasonable distance from players (i.e. 25meters) to avoid any suggestion that you are offering assistance or advice. Players should only obtain information on Rules from Referees who will be on the course.
4. Spectators must remain still and quiet for each shot until all the Players in the group have played or holed out.
5. Spectators must keep away from any ball in play.
6. Spectators are forbidden to carry, transport or handle a player's clubs.
7. Spectators must comply with any instructions or further guidance issued by the EGA in relation to the organisation of the event.
8. Smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages should be kept at a minimum at all events.

TEEING AREAS AND PUTTING GREENS

Spectators must not walk or stand in the teeing areas and putting greens on the course. Spectators should observe the putting green from a reasonable distance that will not interfere with the Players.

LOOKING FOR BALLS

Spectators are welcome to assist with ball spotting and ball searching but must avoid trampling down long grass or touching a found ball.

CELL PHONES

Please set all mobile devices to silence. Spectators must not answer calls while following a group on the course.

Spectators in breach of the above Spectators' Policy will be instructed to leave the course.
